The YSC gives young scientists the opportunity to

- compete with the best of their contemporaries in the world.
- meet others with similar abilities and interests.
- get guidance from some of the most prominent scientists in the world.
- to gain publicity of academic expertise and research

The competition is an initiative of the Young Scientist Committee (<http://www.acb2019.tw/?action=congress02>) of ACB 2019. It was set up to promote the ideals of cooperation and information exchange between young scientists.

Who should apply?

The competition is open to all early-career life scientists, including Master, PhD students and Post-Docs. The winners will receive cash prizes or certificate!

How can I apply?

1. Register for the congress.
2. Submit your abstract via the congress website no later than December 27, 2018.
3. In submission system, select "Young scientist competition"
4. Pay the registration fee.

Presentation Awards and Poster Awards

1. The contestants compete based on their work and interviews with the jury for prizes awarded by ACB 2019 and (sponsors).
2. Award Prize:
 - ✧ USD 300 for the first place of oral presentation
 - ✧ USD 150 for the second place of oral presentation
 - ✧ USD 100 for the third place of oral presentation
 - ✧ Certificate for the Outstanding Oral Presentation Awards.
 - ✧ Certificate for the Best (top three) and Outstanding Poster Awards.
